Recital Tickets – Tickets will go on sale online in mid-April at \$20 per ticket (this includes processing fees/taxes). Receive \$5 off for every 5 tickets purchased to a single show! Tickets will be available the day of the shows at the door and online for a flat \$25 each. More info to come as the sale date approaches!



Important: *The final tuition installment, posted on April 1st must be paid in order for your child to perform in the recital. Please note there will be no tuition posted in May as we base our tuition on 9 monthly installments.

- Backstage Moms Needed for the dress rehearsals and recitals! Starting during Watch Week (beginning 3/6) through Picture Week, a sign-up sheet will be posted in the downstairs waiting room under the tv to place your name with your child's class. Please see the office or your child's teacher with any questions you may have about backstage responsibilities. For the safety of our students, only backstage volunteers will be allowed in the dressing room once the show begins on the day of the show and will require a volunteer t-shirt (this includes during intermission).
- Parent's Watch Week Monday, March 6th-Saturday, March 11th. Please plan to attend, as we will be going over important costume, ticket and rehearsal/recital information. You will need to bring



your child's costume(s) so teachers can show you exactly where the alterations are needed, if any (do not wear costume – we will slip on over leotard & tights).

• **Spring Break** – The studio will be closed for Spring Break vacation from <u>Sunday</u> <u>April 2nd – Sunday, April 9th</u>. Classes will resume on Monday, April 10th. Tuition is based on a seasonal course fee of 34 classes. Regardless of how many classes fall in a month, you must pay your full tuition.

• <u>Recital Assignments</u> can be found below. *This is NOT the show lineup*. This is just an outline of which classes will be in which recital show. Please note we have done our best to keep similar classes and siblings in the same or back to back show as much as possible.

- Try out the class you've always wanted to! During the 3 weeks after the recital, new and current students will be welcome to try out a class of a new style that they may be thinking about taking next year. We just recommend speaking with your child's teacher to see which class level would be best for them to try out.
- Business/Personal Recital Program Patrons We are now accepting business/personal patrons for this year's program. Patrons are due no later than Wednesday, April 12th. This is a great way to show your support for your child's hard work all year in class and/or put the word out about your business! The inside front and back cover are filled on a first come, first serve basis. Please see the office for further info, or visit the "Recital" tab on our website to download a form.
- Recital T-Shirts pre-order due date is <u>Friday, March 31st</u>. We will be ordering a very limited number of additional t-shirts available for purchase at the dress rehearsals and recital. We highly recommend PRE-ORDERING we always sell out early!!!! All performing dancers' names will be listed on the back of each t-shirt. Recital Stuffed Elephants with matching recital tees also available! The 2023 t-shirt design will posted at the studio and on our website in March. <u>Beginning Monday, March 6th</u> forms will be available under the "Recital" tab on our website, or NEW order online through our DSP Online Store!
- Summer Camps and Classes Join us June 19th-22nd for our Acro Camps (beginners advanced, ages 6 & up) and June 26th-29th for our Summer Intensives (for competitive dancers & recreational dancers)! For our dancers ages 3-4 and 5-7, we have Princess Dance Camp featuring Belle, Merida and Cinderella June 26th-28th, Beach Camp featuring Moana, Luca and Lilo & Stitch July 17th-19th, and NEW Alice in Wonderland Camp July 31st August 2nd. For ages 7 & up, we will have Theatre Camps August 7th-9th and TikTok Camps August 1st, 3rd, 8th, and 10th, plus Summer Skills with Miss Claire July 25th & 27th and August 1st & 3rd for ages 7-10! Registration will be live via our website and your Parent Portal in March. Stay tuned for more info on any other camps & pop-up classes!

- Dress Rehearsals No classes will be held at the studio the week prior to the shows: <u>Monday, May</u> <u>8th – Saturday, May 13th</u> as the staff will be at Villa Maria College for dress rehearsals and preparing for the recitals.
 - Dress rehearsals are mandatory and will be spread over the course of three days: <u>May 9th</u>, <u>10th and 11th</u>. Instead of being a run of the show, each class will have a time slot to run their number on stage. This schedule will be released in our April newsletter. Please know that every effort is made to keep similar class levels on the same evenings. <u>All dancers</u> <u>should arrive 15 minutes prior to their scheduled time with hair, makeup and costume on</u>. Please sit with your class in the auditorium upon arrival. If you have 2 or more costume changes, you will be directed where to change.

<u>Class Pictures Schedule – Held at the Studio</u>

- Pictures will be taken during classes, Monday Thursday, April 17th 20th. Each class will have a 30-minute block 15 minutes for pictures and 15 minutes to run their routine in placed of their regular class time.
- Please still arrive <u>10 minutes before</u> your scheduled block time with hair, makeup and costume already on. If you are late we cannot retake the group picture.
- Also, come with picture envelope ready to hand in at the time of your first picture and checks made payable to the photographer, <u>not</u> Hoffman School of Dance. Other options for picture purchases from Creative Photography will be sent out via email soon.
